Currently, 61.6% of the 72,594 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1%, renter occupied; and 5.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 67,720 housing units in the area - 63.5% owner occupied, 30.7% renter occupied, and 5.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.14%. Median home value in the area is \$185,878, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.18% annually to \$217,390.
