Currently, 49.1% of the 127,886 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 42.1%, renter occupied; and 8.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 124,109 housing units in the area - 50.0% owner occupied, 41.4% renter occupied, and 8.6% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.34%. Median home value in the area is \$189,487, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.61% annually to \$215,525.
