# WELD COUNTY ENTERPRISE ZONE (EZ) STATE INCOME TAX CREDITS

Colorado's Enterprise Zone (EZ) program provides state income tax credits to encourage businesses to locate/expand in designated economically distressed areas of the state. Select Weld communities/locations have state EZ designation.

### Program Summary

<u>Pre-certified</u> companies that locate or expand within the physical boundaries of the Weld EZ (see attached Weld Map) are eligible to earn a variety of state income tax credits based on their specific activities primarily in equipment investment, job creation/training, research and development activities, etc., which are summarized below. Earned credits are applied to the company's Colorado income tax liability.

Commercial Vehicle Investment Tax Credit	1.5% of Eligible Commercial Vehicle Purchases
Job Training Investment Tax Credit	12% of Qualified Training Expenses

Job Tax Credit	\$1,100 per Eligible New Job Created
Ag Processing Job Tax Credit	\$500 <u>add'/</u> per Eligible New Job Created
Health Insurance Credit	\$1,000 <u>add'/</u> per Eligible New Job created first two years in EZ
R&D Increase Tax Credit	3% of Increased R&D Expenditures
Vacant Building Rehabilitation Tax Credit	25% of Rehab Expenditures (hard costs)
Manufacturing & Mining Sales/Use Tax	Expanded S&U Tax Exemption in EZ
Approved Contribution Projects	25% of cash contribution /12.5% of approved in-kind contribution

## **EZ Program Administration**

The Weld County EZ is administered by Upstate Colorado Economic Development (Upstate). Detailed program/tax credit information and the Weld County EZ map can be found at <u>www.upstatecolorado.org</u> or by contacting the Upstate office.

#### **Annual Pre-Certification Required**

Colorado has an on-line EZ pre-certification and certification process which can be accessed by going to <u>www.choosecolorado.com/ez.</u> Businesses MUST obtain pre-certification <u>each year</u> prior to engaging in an activity for which they intend to earn a credit. Without this pre-certification, the business will not be able to claim EZ tax credits even if located within the EZ boundaries. Companies can pre-certify up to 3 months prior to the start of the upcoming tax year.

## Updated Weld EZ Boundary Effective 1/1/2016

To determine if a specific location is located within the Weld County EZ, see attached Weld map or contact the Upstate office. An in-depth boundary re-certification process was completed in 2015 and new, state approved EZ boundaries went into effect January 1, 2016.
