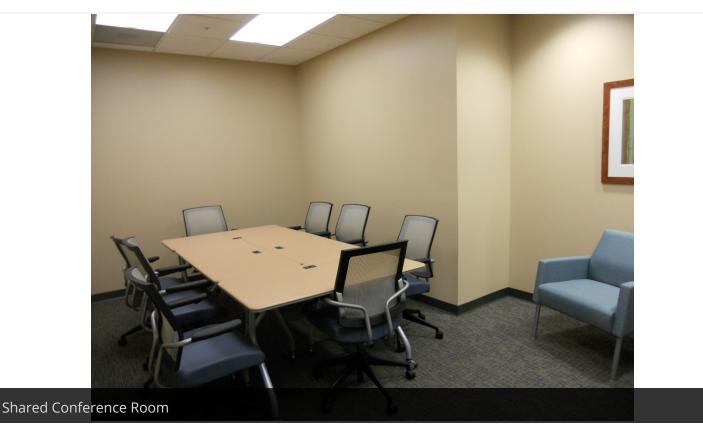

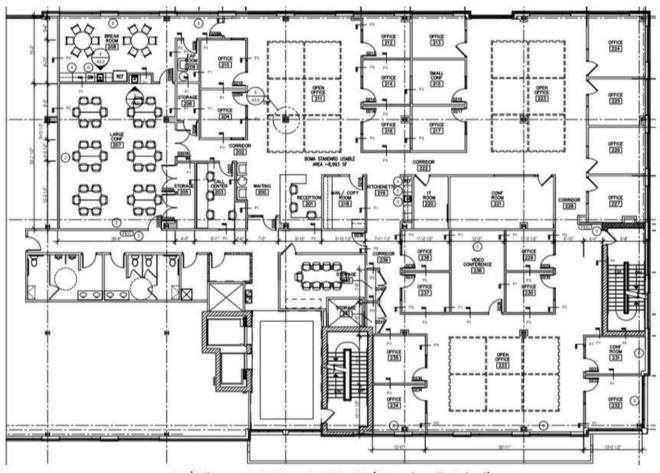

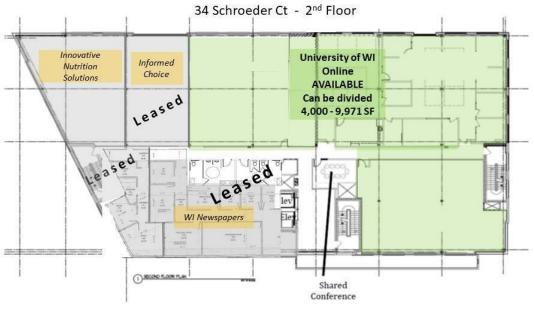

// 3RD FLOOR PLANS

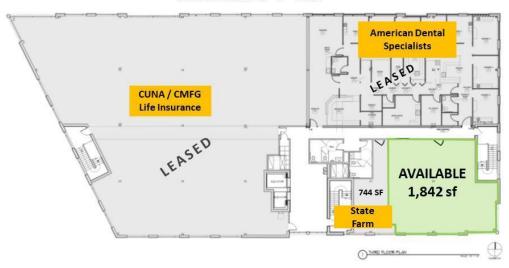
