


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Location/Study Area Map (Rings: 1, 3, 5 mile radius)

Currently, 73.0% of the 56,541 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 23.3%, renter occupied; and 3.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 40,682 housing units in the area - 69.3% owner occupied, 26.7% renter occupied, and 4.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 15.75%. Median home value in the area is \$524,771, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.33% annually to \$560,602.






Demographic and Income (Ring: 1 mile radius)




Population by Age

2019 Population by Race








Demographic and Income (Ring: 3 mile radius)




Population by Age






Demographic and Income (Ring: 5 mile radius)




Population by Age






